### **Summer Session 2006 (Classes begin April 17, 2006)**

### **Transfer Students**

Transfer students shall receive full credit for courses successfully completed at other schools subject to our evaluation and review. At Saint Mary's College of San Juan, we believe in the value of time and money. Students should not waste time and money in repeating subjects they have successfully completed.

### **Schedule of Classes**

Please check with the Registrar's Office for actual course offerings each Semester. For our regular full time students, the block sections shall be offered. If enough number of irregular part time students request for subjects they need, then the School may offer those subjects.

### **Special Tutorial Classes**

These Special Tutorial Classes may be available upon request. These classes will be approved and arranged by the Office of the President for the student and the faculty. The reasons for requesting these Special Tutorial Classes may range from the need to graduate by completing these missing subjects or the student's work schedule conflict to attend the regularly scheduled class.

### **Foreign Students**

We are accredited by the Bureau of Immigration to accept foreign students. Foreign students will have to contact the Office of the President. Some foreign students may require assistance in arranging for initial accommodation and transportation. Some foreign students may need Special Tutorial Classes for certain subjects such as English and Filipino.

## **Yearly July Capping Ceremonies for 3rd Year B.S.N. Students (before hospital duties)**

In July 2006, the 2nd Capping, Candle Lighting, and Pinning Ceremonies shall be held at the Club Filipino, Greenhills, San Juan.
